LARS C. GRAVHOLDT

Lars C. Gravholdt was born at Ulsted, Denmark, April 20, 1872. At the time of his death he was 63 years, 4 months, 10 days of age.

He immigrated to the United States with his parents at the age of ten years. They settled on a homestead near Center Point.

When a young man he became engaged in the well-drilling business, and later on he moved to Powers Lake, N. D., where he took up a homestead of his own and where he has lived ever since, until his health became so poor, four years ago.

He came down to Center Point, Oct. 18, 1934 to make his home with his sister, Mrs. Nels H. Christensen. In July he came to Viborg to renew all his old acquaintances and to stay with his sister, Mrs. Thomas Peterson, where death occurred Jan. 10, 1935.

He leaves to mourn his passing, four sisters and one brother: Mrs. Thomas Peterson, Viborg; Mrs. Nels H. Christensen, Viborg; Mrs. Hans J. Christensen, Hurley; Mrs. John I. Nelson, Irene, and Jens Gravholdt, Irene.

Funeral services were held Monday, Jan. 14 from the Fraternal funeral home and the North Lutheran church. He was laid to rest beside his father in the Lutheran cemetery, three miles west.
