MARIE KREY DIED AT SANITARIUM AT EBEN EZER, COLO.

Laid to Rest Beside Her
Mother in Rose Hill
Cemetery

Bertha Marie Krey was born at Haderslev, Denmark, the 23th, of October 1898, and was baptized in the Lutheran Church at the same place. 1911 she came to this country with her father, Adolph Krey and his wife Else Marie Krey, who died two years ago, here at Viborg.

They located at Wagner, S. Dak., but later moved to Viborg, S. D. where they lived until her mother died. Then Marie had evidently contracted the tubercular disease, to combat this she immediately went to the Eben Ezer Sanatorium Brush, Colo. Here she received the best of care, but in spite of this she succumbed on the 7th, of February 1923.

Marie Krey was shipped to Viborg to be laid to rest in the Rose Hill Cemetery beside her mother. The funeral took place from Bethania Lutheran Church Sunday afternoon at 2:30 P. M. Rev. J. C. Christensen spoke words of comfort to the mourning family; Mrs. J. C. Christensen sang a solo and a quartet sang Marie's favored song, "Rock of Ages Cleft For Me."

Marie was a very pleasant young lady, who made many friends where ever she came.

Patently she bore her cross, (the lingering disease) and with the hope and faith of a christian she welcomed death because it meant eternal life to her.

A large number of out of town guests attended the funeral. Adolph and August Krey of Wagner, S. D. Rev. and Mrs. Peter Krey of Cola, Ill., Chris Krey of St. Louis, Mo. Mr. Theodore Nelson (her uncle) from Nebr.; besides a number of friends from Wagner, S. D.
