Mary M. Larson was b rn March 11th, 1873, at Sargent I luffs, Ia., the second child of Jens and Hannah Larson. At the age of 1 year the family moved to a arm near Beresford, S. Dak., where she remained until the fall of 1893 when she moved to Viborg, to assist her brother Will in the first store in the new city of Viborg. Mary Larson was the first woman to come to the new city of Viborg, to make her home.
