Anne Johanna Christensen, daughter of Hanna and Willads Christensen, was born in Vraa, Vendsyssel, Denmark, on April 29, 1893. She was baptized and confirmed in the Lutheran faith in Denmark. At the age of sixteen she immigrated to America and came to the Viborg vicinity. While there she worked as a housekeeper for her brother Martin, and Martin Christopherson who were engaged in farming.

On February 9, 1915, Anne and Martin were married at Viborg. To this union four children were born. They farmed in the Hurley-Viborg area until the fall of 1964 when they retired and moved into Viborg. Here they resided until her passing at the age of 81 years and about 6 months.

She faithfully attended the First Baptist Church at Viborg and always served the Lord with a willing hand.

Preceding her in death were her parents, six brothers and one sister.
