MRS. JORGINE C. MORRISON

Mrs. Jorgine Christine Morrison was born in Ajstrup, Sogn Vendsyssel, Denmark, October 13th, 1876, and passed away suddenly at the farm home on Saturday morning, February 24th, 1951.

She was baptized at an early age in the Lutheran faith and has been a willing worker in the church at all times.

In 1893 she came to this country, settling in the Irene-Viborg vicinity. In 1894 she was united in marriage to Martin C. Morrison. In 1910 they moved to their present farm home.

To this union were born six children. Her husband and one son, Miller, preceded her in death. She is survived by two daughters, Lillie (Mrs. Martin P. Anderson of Viborg), and Rose (Mrs. Christ Johnson of Everett, Wash.); three sons, Newell, George and Charlie, at home; one brother, Jim Jespersen of Vancouver, Wash.; three sisters and one brother in Denmark; five grandchildren and three great-grandchildren, besides a host of relatives and friends.

She was a kind and loving mother and will be greatly missed.

Funeral services were held Wednesday, February 28th, from the farm home and from the Turkey Valley Lutheran Church. Pallbearers were Adolph Petersen, Howard Petersen, Floyd Swensen, Carl Jensen, Gilbert Christensen, George Fystro. The church choir sang "Beautiful Garden of Prayer" and "God Will Take Care of You", accompanied by Mrs. Joe Gran at the piano. Rev. Stinus S. Loft of New Underwood, Ia., officiated at the services. Interment was in the church cemetery.
