FUNERAL SERVICES HELD FRIDAY FOR MRS. IDA GOODHOPE

Funeral services for Mrs. Ida Goodhope were held Friday afternoon, July 19, from Our Savior's Lutheran Church. Rev. Paul Petersen officiated. Organist was Mrs. L. J. Rasmussen and soloist was Vernon Andersen. Pallbearers were Homer Larsen, Merlin Vannorsdel, Keith Keller, Kim Keller, Chris Madsen and Berl Jorgensen. Interment was in Rosehill Cemetery.

Nettie Inger Emelia Madsen Goodhope, better known to us as Mrs. Ida Goodhope, was born April 23, 1880, in Dwight, Illinois, the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. P. C. Madsen. She moved with her family to Viborg at the age of 10 and lived in Turner County the rest of her life with the exception of two years in Pierre. In 1902 she was united in marriage to A. C. Goodhope. To this union were born two children. Mr. Goodhope died in 1959.

Mrs. Goodhope was an active member of Our Savior's congregation. She was also a member of the Eastern Star.

Following a short illness, Mrs. Goodhope passed away at Pioneer Memorial Hospital in Viborg on Tuesday, July 16, at the age of 88 years.

Besides her husband, she was preceded in death by one daughter, Mrs. Dorothy Lloyd.

She is survived by one daughter, Mrs. Vina Schmidt; two sisters, Mrs. Malinda McSpadden of Texas, and Mrs. Sena Jorgensen of Viborg; one brother, Eddie Madsen of Viborg; three grandchildren and eleven great-grandchildren.
