Last Rites For Mrs. Peter Lund

Funeral services for Mrs. Peter Lund, who passed away last Thursday after a lingering illness, were held on Monday afternoon at the Bethany Lutheran Church, with Rev. K. R. Jensen officiating. The Bethany Ladies Quartet sang "Ivory Palaces" and "Saved By Grace", accompanied by Marilyn Fletcher. Pallbearers were Ervin Holm, Anton Jacobsen, Chris Jorgensen, Carl Lauridsen, Arthur Alendal and Arnold Lauridsen. Interment was at Bethania Cemetery, with the Viborg Funeral Home in charge of arrangements.

Mrs. Ina Marie Lund was born March 29, 1895, in Washington County, Nebraska, to Mr. and Mrs. Christopher Sorensen. She moved with her parents to this community in 1914.

On February 23, 1916, she was united in marriage to Peter Lund, also of this community. With a few short intervals they have lived here since.

Six children were born to the Lund family. A girl and boy died as small children. A son, Daryl, lost his life in the Korean war. Two daughters and one son survive their mother: Lillian (Mrs. Ray Brown) of Reseda, Calif., Geraldine (Mrs. Gerald Reinholt) of Rapid City, S. Dak., and Lloyd of Orange, Calif.

Mrs. Lund suffered a great deal of illness over long periods of time. During the past year she was seriously ill and spent a part of it in California, a part of it at her home, and a part of it at the Viborg Hospital. There she passed away early last Thursday morning. She was a faithful member of the Bethany Congregation.

Besides her husband, two daughters and son-in-laws, one son and daughter-in-law, she leaves to mourn, her seven grandchildren, one sister, Mrs. Chris O. Hansen, and one brother, Soren Sorensen, both of Viborg. Also a host of other relatives and friends.
