FUNERAL SERVICES HELD SATURDAY FOR CARRIE E. TONE

Funeral services for Carrie E. Tone were held on Saturday, May 24, 1980, from the Bethany Lutheran Church in Viborg with Pastor Norman Wahl officiating.
