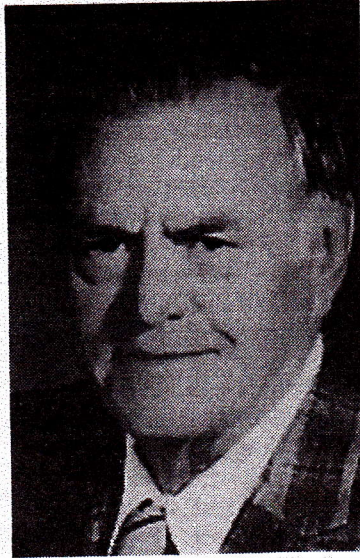


FLYGER, Fred W.

Fred W. Flyger was born August 20, 1922 on the family homestead at Parker. His parents were Arthur J. and Mabel (Madsen) Flyger.

He attended country school and graduated from Hurley High School in the Class of 1941. Fred married Dorothy B. Pasco on August 20, 1946 at Sioux Falls. They made their home in Viborg where he was employed at the Scandinavian Co-op Creamery as a truck driver for eleven years. Fred purchased the Standard Oil Agency in 1959 and worked as the Stan-

dard Oil agent. He purchased the Standard Oil Jobbership from Standard Oil in 1975 and operated the business under the trade name of Flyger Petroleum Company. Fred sold the business to Stern Oil Company of Freeman in 1980 and then in 1986 they moved to Sioux Falls where he was presently employed at Randall's Foods. He was a strong supporter of all community activities. He was a member of the Viborg Commercial Club, the Joppa Lodge #120 of Hurley, the Crown Chapter #37 of Hurley and the United Methodist Church of Viborg. He was interested in sports, hunting and fishing. He especially enjoyed following his children's and grandchildren's activities.

Fred passed away on October 27, 2001 at Sioux Valley Hospital in Sioux Falls. He had attained the age of 79.

He was preceded in death by his parents; one son Fred Claire; one sister Ardell Zastrow; and one brother Arthur J. Flyger.
