Services Held For Warren E. Miller

Warren E. Miller, 65, 602 North Broadway, passed away February 20 at a Sioux Falls hospital. Funeral services were held in the Grace Lutheran Church with the Rev. Diedrik A. Nelson officiating. Interment Mt. Hope Cemetery. Organist was Mrs. Doris Nelson and soloist was Jerry Stolp.
