CHARLES O. JENSEN

Funeral services for Charles O. Jensen were held July 31st from the McColby Funeral Chapel at Custer, S. Dak. The Rev. Mr. R. W. Uecker of the Lutheran Church officiated. Mrs. R. W. Uecker, soloist, sang "Abide With Me" and "What A Friend We Have In Jesus". Mrs. W. L. Meyer was the organist. Interment was in the cemetery at Custer.

Charles O. Jensen was born on Nov. 17, 1898, near Viborg and passed away at the Lutheran Hospital in Hot Springs, S. Dak., on July 28. He was united in marriage to Myrtle Moen on April 26, 1930. To this union four sons were born, two of whom passed away in infancy.

Mr. and Mrs. Jensen lived around Viborg and Irene until 1951 when they moved to Custer.

Survivors include his wife, Myrtle, two sons, Charles of Hot Springs and Albert of Denver, Colo., and one grand-daughter.
