Last Rites Held For Henry Olson

OBITUARY

Henry Olson was born at Racine, Wisc., May 29, 1880, the son of Nels Christian and Marie Olson. At the age of 10 he moved with his parents to Viborg, S. Dak., and later to Sundance, Wyo., where he managed a ranch with his father.

He was united in marriage to Celia Partlow at Sundance, Wyo., in June, 1910. After a year spent on his father's ranch near Sundance, Mr. and Mrs. Olson returned to Viborg where Mr. Olson was employed as janitor of the Viborg Public Schools, a position he held for 21 years. Celia Partlow Olson passed away in August, 1943. The following year he moved to Moorcroft, Wyo., where he was employed as janitor in the schools for two years. He was married to Anne Ormsley at Gillette, Wyo., on January 7, 1945. The past year and a half he was employed at St. Joseph Hospital in Deadwood, S. Dak. He was a member of the First Baptist church and was janitor of our local church for many years.

He is survived by his wife, Anne, his sister, Mrs. Harvey Monk, of Beresford, S. Dak., and a brother, David, of Sioux Falls, and a host of friends. Two brothers and one sister preceded him in death.
