## **FUNERAL SERVICES HELD HERE TUESDAY FOR LOUIE MANZEL**

Funeral services for Louie Manzel, 69, were held on Tuesday, Dec. 17th from Our Savior's Lutheran Church in Viborg. Mr. Manzel died at Sacred Heart Hospital in Yankton on Saturday, Dec. 14, following a short illness. Rev. Paul Petersen officiated at the services. Organist was Mrs. L. J. Rasmussen and soloist was Mr. Vernon Andersen. Pallbearers were Ralph Lauritzen, Jim Buckstead, Merle Strunk, Omar Karp, Veryl Paulsen and Larry Gaddis. Interment was in Rosehill Cemetery.

Louie Manzel was born September 20, 1899, in Fremont, Nebraska, the son of Mr. and Mrs. Charles Manzel. As a young man he moved to South Dakota.

On June 29, 1927, he was united in marriage to Millicent Nelson. To this union three children were born. Mr. and Mrs. Manzel farmed in the Centerville area their entire married life. Mrs. Manzel passed away May 18, 1968.
