Ruby V. Luden, 84, died on Monday, February 18th at the Pioneer Memorial Nursing home in Viborg where she has been a resident for 4 years.

Funeral services were held on February 21, 1985 at 2:00 p.m., at the Anderson Funeral Home with Rev. David Mack officiating.

She was born on November 15, 1900 to Albert P. and Edna Millage in Lincoln County. She attended rural school in Lincoln County and Augustana Academy in Canton, S. D., then taught rural school in Turner County for several years.
