Funeral Services For Jim Lineback Held Monday, Feb. 14th

Last rites for Jim Lineback, who died suddenly on Thursday, Feb. 10th, were held on Monday, Feb. 14th, at 1:30 P. M., at the First Baptist Church in Viborg. Rev. Ben Zimmerman officiated. Interment was at Rose Hill cemetery in Parker. Pallbearers were Art Loe, Joe Altstiel, Orville Flint, Elmer Holm, Adolph Tronbak, and Tosten Williamson. Three songs, "Good Night and Good Morning", "In The Garden" and "Beyond The Sunset", were sung by Miss Virginia Tronbak. Organist was Mrs. Oliver Anderson.

James Dennis Lineback was born September 30, 1888, at Meriden, Cherokee County, Iowa, and departed from this life on Thursday, Feb. 10th, 1955, following a heart attack. He grew to manhood in Cherokee County and was educated there. He was baptised in the Catholic faith at Marcus, Iowa.

On January 17th, 1911, he was united in marriage to Emma Fogelman at Marcus, Iowa. To this union eight children were born.

In March, 1911, Mr. Lineback moved to Parker, S. Dak. He made his home at Winner, S. Dak., from 1918 until 1928. He then returned to Turner County. Mr. Lineback was engaged in farming until 1938. At that time he moved to Viborg and entered the trucking business.

He leaves to mourn, his wife, two sons, Kenneth and Emery of Viborg, four daughters, Blanch Mrs. Harold Christensen, Burbank, S. Dak., Audrey (Mrs. Lavern Hippen), Irene, S.
