Funeral Held For Annie M. Larson

Funeral service for Annie M. Larson was held November 25, 1988, at Bethany Lutheran Church with The Rev. Kevin Lee officiating. Organist was Helen Holm with special music by Dallas Johnson and Diane Rahn. Honorary pallbearers were her grandchildren and pallbearers were Rodney Mikkelsen, Ronald Nygaard, Larry Langeland, Timothy Eide, Dallas Johnson, and Loren Kube. Interment was in Spring Valley Lutheran Cemetery in Viborg, South Dakota.

Annie M. Larson was born on a farm in Yankton County near Irene on February 18, 1901, the daughter of George and Mathilda (Malgard) Johnson. She attended District No. 55 rural school and Yankton Academy.

She was married to L. P. Larsen, Jr. on March 19, 1919, at Irene. They farmed in Turner County, rural Viborg until retiring into Viborg in 1953. He preceded her in death on November 11, 1955. She continued to make her home in Viborg.

On April 11, 1966, she was married to Lee Larson at Luverne, Minnesota. They lived in Viborg their entire married life. He preceded her in death on February 15, 1988. She had been a resident of a nursing home since March of 1987. She was a member of

Bethany Lutheran Church in Viborg.

Having been in declining health, Annie died suddenly following a short illness on November 21, 1988, at Pioneer Memorial Hospital in Viborg. She attained the age of 87 years, nine months and three days.

Surviving are five children: Mrs. Henry (June) Winterboer of Davis, Mrs. John (Vivian) Johnson of Worthing, Mrs. Kermit (LaVonne) Mikkelsen of Irene, Mrs. Merle (Glennys) Langeland of Viborg, and LaVerne Larsen of Yankton; 13 grandchildren; 37 great-grandchildren; and 9 great-great-grandchildren.
