FUNERAL SERVICES HELD WEDNESDAY FOR NICK NELSON

Funeral services for Nick Nelson were held on Wednesday, January 4th, 1961, at 2:00 P.M., at the Methodist Church in Viborg with Rev. Robert McBride officiating. Mr. Nelson passed away at the Pioneer Memorial Hospital where he had been a patient for some time on January 1, 1961. Mrs. Fred Flyger was pianist and Mrs. Robert Ward, soloist, at the services. Pallbearers were Fletcher Nelson, Curtis Nelson, Gifford Sherard, Merlyn Nelson, Udell Nelson and Maurice Nelson. Interment was in Rosehill cemetery, Viborg.

Nicholas Nelson was born in Denmark on August 15, 1876. He came to this country in 1879 with his parents. He was united in marriage to Carrie Nelson in 1904, and to this union one son was born. In 1918 Carrie Nelson passed away, and following her death, he moved to Viborg where he operated a grain elevator for many years.

In 1922 he was united in marriage to Annie Anderson, and to this union one son was born. Nick was a member of the Methodist Church of Viborg, and was a member of the Masonic Lodge since 1918. He will be remembered by his countless friends as a friendly and generous man. He was a conscientious business man and a devout Christian.

He passed away January 1, 1961, at the Pioneer Memorial Hospital, after a long illness.

He leaves to mourn his passing, his wife Annie; two sons, Sylvester of Des Moines, Iowa, and Dale of Sioux Falls; four step-daughters, Mrs. Vina Helm of Omaha, Mrs. Carl Lauridsen of Viborg, Mrs. Carl Meyer of Hartford, and Mrs. Blanche Fejfar of Sioux Falls; nine grandchildren; ten great-grandchildren; four sisters; and six brothers.
