Funeral Services Held For Mrs. Alvin Doering

Funeral services for Mrs. Alvin Doering were held from Spring Valley Lutheran Church on Wednesday, May 20th. Rev. Wallis N. Larson officiated. Organist was Mrs. Dennis Sletten and soloist was Mr. Curtis Anderson. Pallbearers were Loran Wiedmeier, Murray Westergaard, Ray Hockhalter, Guy Warnock, Ray Strunk, and Garland Olesen. Interment was in Carlson Cemetery.

Mary Kathryn Jorgensen Doering was born December 16, 1945. She attended grade school in Turner County and graduated from Hurley High School in 1963. She then graduated from the Professional Business Institute at Minneapolis, Minnesota, in 1964.

She was baptized and confirmed at the Spring Valley Lutheran Church.

Mary was united in marriage to Alvin Wayne Doering September 3, 1966.

She was employed by the Yankton Police Dept. as a meter maid and at present she was employed by Dale Electronics, also of Yankton, S. Dak.

Survivors include the widower; a son, Michael, 16 months; her parents, Mr. and Mrs. Arnie Jorgensen, Viborg; a brother, Wayne, in Vietnam; a sister, Gayle, Yankton; and a grandmother, Mrs. Christine Jorgensen, Viborg.

A traffic accident which occurred Saturday, May 16th, at 3 P.M., 11 miles west and 2 miles north of Viborg claimed its second victim on Monday, May 25th, when Mrs. Joseph Heirigs, 42, died of injuries received in the accident. Mrs. Heirigs had been in the intensive care ward at McKennan Hospital in critical condition since the accident. Mrs. Alvin Doering, 24, was killed instantly in the accident which occurred at the intersection of a township and county road. The Doering's 15 month old son Michael was taken to Pioneer Memorial Hospital at Viborg where he was treated and released.

Funeral services were held Wednesday, May 20, from Spring Valley Church for Mrs. Doering.

Prayer services for Mrs. Heirigs will be held at 8 P.M. Thursday evening at St. Boniface Church and funeral mass will be held at 10 o'clock Friday.
