Mrs. Anna Amelia Christensen was born October 26th, 1873, in Chicago, Ill., the daughter of Mads and Anna Catharine Pedersen.

At the age of six months, she came to South Dakota with her parents and remained until, at the age of six years, they returned to Chicago.

She was united in marriage to Jens Peter Christensen on June 18th, 1892, in Chicago. They moved to Viborg in 1913 where they engaged in the jewelry business. Mr. Christensen died on April 20, 1932.

She is survived by her three children, Mrs. Frank Christensen (Esther), of Huron, Charles E. Christensen of Irene, and Mrs. Kenneth Hatch (Myrtle) of Waukonda; eleven grandchildren and three great grandchildren.

She was a member of the Danish Sisters and of Turner Rebekah Lodge.
