FUNERAL SERVICES HELD APRIL 28 FOR IVER H. LEE

Funeral services for Iver H. Lee were held from the Hansen Funeral Home in Irene on Saturday, April 28th, with Rev. Gerhard Landgrebe officiating. Organist was Mrs. Merle Johnson, and soloist was Mrs. Jack Rudd who sang "God Hath Not Promised" and "The Old Rugged Cross". Active pallbearers were Harold Peterson, Mervil Peterson, Mervin Eide, and Olaf Hanson. Honorary pallbearers were Chris Brandser, Cecil Groetken, Praben Lee, and Ole Rockne. Interment was in Meldal Cemetery.

Iver H. Lee was born April 9, 1894, to Hans and Mari Lee on his parents' homestead located 2 miles west of Center Point. He was baptized and confirmed in the Meldal Lutheran Church. He attended rural school in Yankton County.

He entered the service during WWI. After discharge he was engaged in farming and raising livestock. He also operated a grain threshing rig for several years.

He retired during the 1950's but remained on the farm located just north of the homestead.

He became ill the first of March of this year. He entered the V.A. Hospital at Sioux Falls on March 26. He was transferred to the Nursing Home and then the Viborg Hospital where he passed away April 25.

He was preceded in death by his parents, three sisters—Amanda, Mathilda and Ragna, and his brother Gilbert.

He is survived by his sister, Ida, of rural Viborg; a niece and nephews, several cousins, and many friends.
