FUNERAL SERVICES HELD MONDAY FOR EDWIN CHRISTENSEN

Funeral services for Edwin H. Christensen were held on Monday, Oct. 18, 1976, from the Bethany Lutheran Church in Viborg, S. D. Pastor Virgil White officiated. Organist was Mrs. James Oakland, and soloist was Mr. Darrell Christensen who sang "My God and I" and "Under His Wings". A congregation hymn, "Beautiful Savior", was also sung. Pallbearers were: Gerald Morrison, Lester Hansen, Thomas Nooney, Norman Osthus, LuVerne Christensen and Kenneth Mork. Interment was in the Baptist Cemetery.

Edwin H. Christensen, son of Emmer and Trana Christensen, was born on a farm southeast of Viborg on April 15, 1893.

He passed away October 15, 1976, at Pioneer Memorial Hospital, Viborg, South Dakota.

On October 13, 1914, he was married to Catherine J. Sorensen of Irene, South Dakota.

Edwin served in the United States Army from 1917 to 1919. Other than the time in service he farmed in the Viborg area.

Edwin and Catherine retired into Viborg in 1958.

There were four children born to this union, two passing on before their father. One son, Harold, passed away in infancy, and one son, Charles, in the service of his country during World War II.

Edwin is survived by his wife, Catherine; one son, Delano of Viborg, South Dakota; one daughter, Correne, Mrs. Leonard Hofer, Toledo, Ohio; five grandchildren, and one brother, Nels Christensen of Viborg, S. D.
