Bennie Halle, son of Mr. and Mrs. Andrew B. Halle, was born in Turner County near Hooker, South Dakota, on May 3, 1893. He was baptized and confirmed into the Lutheran faith.

On November 11, 1916, he was united in marriage to Alta Jensen. To this union two children were born: Clinton, Hawarden, Iowa, and Wanda (Mrs. Reuben Sorensen), Viborg, S. Dak.

Together with his wife he spent his life farming in Turner County until six years ago when illness forced his retirement. Three years later he and his wife moved to Viborg where he spent the rest of his life.

He died on Oct. 18, 1963, at the age of 70 years, 5 months and 15 days.

He was preceded in death by his parents.

He is survived by his wife, Alta, two children, three grandchildren, and a host of friends and relatives.
