Funeral Held For Louie Christensen

Funeral services were held on Wednesday, May 10, 1989, at 10:00 a.m. in the Hurley United Methodist Church for Louie B. Christensen. He passed away on Sunday, May 7 at Pioneer Memorial Hospital, Viborg.

Officiating at the service was Rev. Randall Spahr, with Mrs. Virgil Christensen as organist and Arden Flyger, soloist. Pallbearers were Skip Christensen, Jeb Christensen, Bob Thompson, Randi Thompson, Don Gerdes and Ted Neuhauser. Ushers were Ejner Andersen and Bob Christopherson.

He was laid to rest in the Hurley Cemetery.

Louie B. Christensen, 86, son of Hans J. and Stena (Gravholdt) Christensen, was born in a sod house near Center Point, Spring Valley Township, South Dakota, on September 26, 1902. At the age of nine, he moved with his parents to a farm six miles west of Hurley.

On February 20, 1932, he married Violet Smith at Hurley. They farmed until 1959, when they sold their farm and moved into Hurley. It was at this time he started to do custom painting, retiring in 1984.

He was a member of the Hurley United Methodist Church.

Louie leaves to mourn, his wife, Violet; two sisters, Mrs. Eigel Christensen, Pomona, Calif., and Mrs. Belvia Britton, LaGuna Hills, Calif., and a brother, Berven, Yankton, SD.
