Harland H.P. Danielson was born July 17, 1919 to Jorgen and Mabel (Hansen) Danielson. He was called to his heavenly home on January 5, 2014.

Memorial services were held on Thursday, January 9, 2014 at 10:00 a.m. in the Spring Valley Lutheran Church (Viborg). Pastor Steve Unzicker officiated and Harland A. He was a member of Spring Valley Lutheran Church and the Viborg American Legion. He had served on the church, township, funeral home and Scandinavian Coop Creamery boards.
