LAST RITES HELD FOR HALDUR MADSEN

Funeral services were held on Tuesday, Aug. 5th, for Haldur Madsen, 71, who died Saturday, Aug. 2nd. Funeral services were held from the Viborg Funeral Home with Pastor Noel Vold officiating. Organist was Mrs. Helen Holm and Darrell Christensen was soloist. Pallbearers were Alden Christensen, Kilmer Christensen, Harold Dawson, Robert Sanborn, LuVerne Christensen and Hartvig Hansen. Interment was at Spring Valley Lutheran Cemetery.

Haldur Madsen was born in Ryde Sogn, Denmark, on Jan. 1, 1898 to Mr. and Mrs. Niels Madsen. He was baptized and confirmed in the Lutheran faith in Denmark. Since coming to America Mr. Madsen farmed in the Viborg area all but 4 years which was spent on defense work in Hawaii, the Aleutian Islands and Alsaka, helping to build the Alcan Highway.

He was preceded in death by his parents and seven brothers and sisters. He is survived by one sister, Mrs. C. K. Christensen, Viborg.
