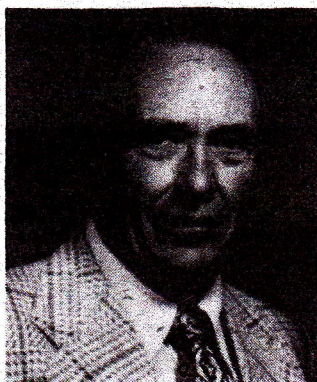

Services Held For Viggo Nelson



The funeral service for Viggo Nelson was held at 1:30 p.m. on Monday, April 20 at the United Methodist Church with Rev. Randall Spahr officiating.

Dorothy Guenther was organist and Dean Josephsen, soloist, sang "One Day at a Time" and "Amazing Grace." The congregational hymn was "This is My Father's World."

Ushers were Len Aman and Wally Benson.

Pallbearers were Donald Smith, Pete Andersen, Douglas Rogers, Leon Wellman, Orval Winterboer and Gary Richter.

He was laid to rest in the Lennox Cemetery.

Viggo Wesley Nelson, 67, was born at rural Davis on May 9, 1919, the son of Chris and Anna (Petersen) Nelson. He died Friday, April 17, 1987, at Sioux Valley Hospital, Sioux Falls.

He attended Middleton District #23, rural Davis and graduated from Davis High School.

On October 27, 1940, Viggo was united in marriage to Erma Farmer at Lennox. They lived in the Davis area and farmed until 1963 when Viggo joined a seed corn company as sales manager. At the time of his death, he was serving as a sales manager for Paymaster Seeds.

Mr. Nelson was a

member of the United Methodist Church of Parker and a past chairman of the official board of the church. He was a member of the Masonic Lodge at Arlington, Yankton Consistory and El Riad Shrine.

Grateful for having shared his life are his wife, Erma; two sons, Michael Nelson and his wife, Janice, of Kimball, Nebraska, and Merlin Nelson of Hartford, Wisconsin; two grandchildren, Jamie and Jonathan Nelson of Kimball, Nebraska; a brother, Emert, of Englewood, Florida; two sisters, Louella Bingner and Lillian Noteboom of Viborg; several nieces and nephews and a host of other relatives and friends.

Preceding him in death were his parents and a brother, Kermit Nelson.
