Viborg Community Mourns the Loss of Rothschadl

A Viborg, SD teen died in a one-vehicle rollover crash on U.S. 18 approximately 6-miles east of Davis, SD on April 28, 2012.

Courtney Rothschadl, 19, was westbound on U.S. 18, east of the intersection of 466th Avenue when she lost control of the 1992 Buick Le Sabre she was driving. Rothschadl lost control of her vehicle and the vehicle rolled. Rothschadl, who was not wearing a seatbelt was ejected from the vehicle and suffered fatal injuries. Justin Johnson was a passenger in the vehicle at the time of the crash and was transported to Sanford Hospital in Sioux Falls with non-life threatening injuries.

No further information regarding the crash investigation is available.

The crash remains under investigation by the South Dakota Highway Patrol. The Lincoln County Sheriff's Office, Lennox Police Department, Lennox Fire and Rescue, and Lennox Ambulance assisted at the scene.
