Obituary

JEP PETERSON LUND

Jep Peterson Lund was born in Molby Oseonwat Soyn, Denmark on May 9, 1866. He was baptized and confirmed in the local Lutheran parish at Tirslund Brorup Soyn, where he also received his elementary training. In 1890, he was married to Karin Marie Larsen Strom and two children were born to this union, Peter and Mrs. Lawrence Petersen, both of Viborg.

The occupation which Mr. Lund pursued as a young man in Denmark was that of drainage engineering. Upon coming to the United States in 1901 and settling in the Viborg community, he engaged in farming until age and health caused him to retire and move into Viborg, where he resided until his death. His wife died on October 31, 1939. Mr. Lund, although busy in his occupation, found time to serve his church by holding various offices in the congregation. His last illness began on September 1st, and in spite of loving care passed away on Friday, September 13, leaving to mourn his death, his son, daughter, eight grandchildren, three great grandchildren, a brother Nels, living in Yankton and relatives in Denmark, also many relatives and friends in this community.

Funeral services were held on Monday from Bethany Lutheran Church with Rev. M. Harry Pedersen officiating. Special music was rendered by a girls' sextette at the church. Pallbearers were Anton Jacobsen, Hans Kaarup, C. M. Andersen, Chris Jorgensen, Alfred Morgensen and C. O. Hansen. Interment was in the Bethany Cemetery.
