OBITUARY

Martin T. Anderson, son of Mr. and Mrs. Chris Anderson was born at Dwight, Ill., September 15th, 1899. In 1911 he came with his parents to Viborg, S. D. Martin always stayed at home and helped his father on the farm until last fall, when he went to the Dakota College, Blair, Neb. Here however, he had the misfortune to contract a cold, which ultimately settled in and about his lungs causing pleurisy. This caused his death the 21st of Febr. and on the 23 he was brought home, a corpse.

Martin was of a kind disposition and easily won the friendship of those whom he associated with; his conduct was exemplary, and he was of a sincere religious nature, so that his seat in the house of worship never stood vacant during services. We naturally ask why are such young men called away?

The burial took place from the Bethania Lutheran Church on Thursday and interment at the Lutheran Cemetery 3 miles west. Rev. J. C. Christensen officiated and Rev. Th. N.
