Final Rites Held For Mrs. Andrew Paulsen

Funeral services for Mrs. Andrew Paulsen were held at the Turkey Valley Baptist Church on Wednesday, October 9th, Rev. Ben Zimmerman officiating. Serving as pallbearers were Grant Jensen, Clarence Olsen, Robert Paulsen, Louie Manzel, Larry Gaddis and Richard Sorensen. Interment was at the Turkey Valley Baptist cemetery.

Mrs. Etta Elnora Paulsen (Mrs. Andrew Paulsen), the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Nels Chris Mork, was born on a farm 5 miles west and 2 miles south of Viborg on April 23, 1903.

She was united in marriage to Mr. Andrew Paulsen on February 22, 1928. To this union were born two sons, namely, Orland of Rapid City, and Veryl, stationed in Germany in the U. S. Army.

She was a member of the Turkey Valley Baptist Church which she joined upon baptism in her early teens. She was a faithful worker in her church, being a Sunday School teacher upon her death. She also held various offices in the church during her lifetime.

She passed away suddenly on Thursday afternoon, October 3, at the Sacred Heart Hospital in Yankton, having reached the age of 54 years, 5 months and 11 days. She was preceded in death by her father and one brother, Orville.
