FUNERAL SERVICES HELD SATURDAY FOR EMIL ASTORP

Funeral services for Emil Astorp were held on Saturday, Nov. 16, 1974, from Our Savior's Lutheran Church in Viborg with Pastor Donald Love officiating. Interment was in Rosehill Cemetery.

Emil Astorp was born in Aalborg, Denmark. He came to the United States as a young man. He worked in the creamery in Albert Lea, Minn., until 1933 when he came to Center Point to manage the creamery.

He was married to Luvella Nelson on Sept. 8, 1934. In 1936 they moved to Gwinner, N. D., where he was a creamery operator until retirement in 1970. They moved to Viborg. He was a member of Our Savior's Church.

On Wednesday, Nov. 13, Emil passed away at Pioneer Memorial Hospital in Viborg.

Survivors include his widow; one son, Norman, of Sumner, Iowa; one daughter, Margaret Mandall, of Woodland, Calif.; one grandson; and two sisters and three brothers in Denmark.
