Carl A. Olsen was born in Stavanger, Norway, Dec. 31, 1865, where he lived with his parents until he was 16 years of age when he came to the United States in 1881, living in Illinois the first four years. In 1883 his parents and brothers and sisters joined him there and in 1895 the family moved to Turner county, Dakota territory. He passed away Oct. 18, 1925, after a short illness of pneumonia.

In 1891 deceased was united in marriage to Annie Oakland and they continued to reside in Turner county until 1907 when they moved to Grant county, where they resided until 1911 when they moved to Zieback county, where he made his home until his death.

Deceased was one of the highly respected and substantial citizens of the county, was a kind and indulgent husband and father and a good neighbor.

The deceased is survived by a wife and six children, as follows: Norman Olsen of Eagle Butte, Edgar Olsen of Dupree, Charles Olson, Alice Shannon and Myrtle Olsen of Antrim, besides four sisters and two brothers.

Funeral services were held at the family residence southeast of Lantrim, conducted by Rev. Morris Eggen of Faith, after which the remains were laid to rest in Eagle Butte cemetery.—Eagle Butte News.
