They farmed for eight years, and then went into the Center Point Grocery store which was the K&M., and he also did spraying and fertilizing for the area farmers for 30 years. They have been retired for about the last 16 years, but continued to reside at Center Point, where Kenneth passed away very suddenly at his home, April 21, 1992 at the age of 78.

Preceding him in death were his parents, a sister Sadie in infancy, and three brothers, Noble, Audley and Golden.
