Clinton Halle, son of Alta Jensen Halle and Bennie Halle, was born July 7, 1917 in Viborg. He grew up and attended school here, graduating from Viborg High. He then attended Southern State Teachers College at Springfield, S. D., later entering the Air Force in 1943.

On February 16, 1946, Clinton married Ellen Johnson in Sioux Falls. He enrolled at Colorado A&M and later at the University of South Dakota at Vermillion, where he received his Masters Degree.

Clinton taught school in Viborg, was the superintendent of schools in Tabor and Freeman, S. D. The family then settled in Hawarden, Ia., he taught industrial arts for 19 years, retiring in 1981. The family then moved to Sioux Falls.
