OBITUARY

Charley F. Frederickson was born on a farm in Clay county, near Beresford, S. D., on March 9th, 1873. He was baptised and confirmed in the Lutheran faith, attended school and grew to manhood in the Beresford vicinity. He later started farming on the old homestead. He was married to Mary Christensen on April 8, 1896. To this union were born 10 children. Five having passed away in infancy. Surviving are five sons, Arnold of Sioux Falls, Dell, Raymond and Wilbur of Viborg, and Warren of Seattle, Wash. Also seven grand children, three sisters, Mrs. Julia Christensen of Beresford, S. D., Mrs. Katie Nelson of Scotland, S. D., and Mrs. Abel Rasmussen of Beresford; and two brothers, William of Winner, S. D., and Herman Jepson of Owatonna, Minn.

In 1902 he moved to a farm two miles northeast of Viborg, where he lived for 44 years. Two years ago he built a home in Viborg. During the time he was on the farm, he served on the school board for 28 years and on Swan Lake township board for several years.

He became suddenly ill on June 29th, and passed away Friday morning, July 2nd, 1948, at the age of 75 years, 3 months and 23 days.

Mrs. Frederickson preceded him in death on March 27th, 1940.

Charley, as he was familiarly known, had many relatives and a host of friends who will cherish his memory.
