NELS W. NELSON PASSED AWAY AT YANKTON HOSPITAL

Has Been in Poor Health
for a Numver of
Years

CANCER CAUSE OF HIS DEATH

Funeral Services Held Last Monday From Baptist Church

Friday afternoon, April 25th, 1924, at the Yankton hospital, Nels W. Nelson peacefully slept away. Although he has been in poor health for a number of years but it was not known until about six months ago that he was suffering from cancer.

Nels was a son of Mr. and Mrs. Andrew M. Nelson, and was born at Fowler, Indiana, July 24th 1886. At the age of about two years he, with his parents, moved to Turner county and has lived in this vicinity since that time. Mr. Nelson was at the time of his death 37 years, 9 months and 1 day of age.

On January 26th, 1916, he was married to Miss Mae Peterson. To this union four children were born, two passing away in infancy.

Besides his wife and children, he leaves to mourn his loss, his father and mother, Mr. and Mrs. Andrew M. Nelson of Sioux Falls, six brothers and two sisters: Lawrence Nelson, Brooklyn, N.
