## LAST RITES HELD HERE MONDAY FOR WENDELL PETERSON

Funeral services for Wendell P. Peterson, 69, were held from Our Savior's Lutheran Church in Viborg on Monday, Feb. 21st, with Rev. Paul Petersen officiating. Mrs. L. J. Rasmussen was organist. Pallbearers were: Lyle Peterson, Robert Thompson, Dean Peterson, Eldon Frederickson, Phillip Johnson and Lynn Hansen. Interment was in Evergreen Cemetery.

Services for Mr. Peterson were also held on Saturday, Feb. 19th, from the Tabor Lutheran Church in Strandburg, South Dakota.

Wendell P. Peterson was born at Viborg, South Dakota, on May 14, 1902, the son of Jens and Trena Peterson.

On October 12, 1927, he was united in marriage to Sylvia Hansen. The couple farmed west of Viborg until 1941 when they moved to a farm in Grant County. In 1955 they retired, moving to Stockholm, S. D.

Wendell Peterson passed away on February 16, at Stockholm. He was a member of Tabor Lutheran Church of Strandburg, S. D., where services were held in his memory on Saturday.

He was preceded in death by his parents and two brothers. Besides his wife, Sylvia, he is survived by four sons: Merle of Minneapolis, Minn., Maynard of St. Cloud, Minn., Maurice of Eau Claire, Wis., and Allan of New Effington; one daughter, Marjorie, Mrs. Milton Allison of Ames, Iowa; and 19 grandchildren. He is also survived by four brothers: Mervin of California, Melvin and Ralph of Viborg, and Jimmie of Centerville; and two sisters, Mrs. Effie Christensen of Viborg and Mayme, Mrs. Harry Thompson of Hurley.
