A. B. Halle Killed.

The sad news reached Viborg this morning that A. B. Hall, who bought the Chris Jensen Skeen farm northeast of town had been killed. He was at work hauling wheat to the stack last Tuesday and in climbing onto a load he fell off in front of the wagon and at the same time the horses started up, causing two wheels to pass over his shoulders and back. He was taken to his home and a physician was immediately summoned and everything was done to relieve his suffering, but he died Wednesday night. Mr. Hall was an old resident and served as section foreman at Hooker for a number of years. Later he moved onto a farm in Lincoln county, and last year he bought the Skeen place. He was a kind and respected citizen and the whole community feels his sudden demise keenly. He leaves a wife and an adopted son to mourn him—he having adopted one of Fred Bauman's children when he was killed by Hammond a short time ago. His funeral will be held from the house on Friday at 2 o'clock.
