Emmet Lauritzen Rites Held Tuesday, April 21

Funeral services for Emmet Lauritzen 29, who passed away at home quite suddenly Saturday morning, were conducted Tuesday afternoon, April 21, from Our Savior's Lutheran Church with Rev.
