MRS. DANIEL ELIASSEN DEAD

This community was shocked last Friday morning when it was learned that Mrs. Eliassen had died at her home. She had not been sick but was subject to weak spells, caused by heart trouble and it was from this cause that she died.

Karen Marie Eliassen born Hansen was born in Outrup, Mors Denmark, Feb. 20, 1849. She was married to Daniel Eliassen in 1874, and made their home in Rom Sogn, near Lemvig.

In 1890 they emigrated to America and settled in South Dakota, where they have farmed at different places. During the past seven years they have resided in Viborg.

Their married life has been blessed with five children, three of them are dead. The two that are alive are Mrs. M. T. Michaelsen, of Center Point, and Chris who lives in Grant county.

The funeral was held last Monday and the funeral sermon was preached by Rev. Kristensen of the Lutheran church, and the remains were laid to rest in the Lutheran cemetery three miles west of Viborg, besides her son who died a few year ago. Peace be with her ashes.
