**A. AALBORG, BROTHER OF  
CHARLEY AALBORG DIES  
AT FAIRMONT, MINN.**

Funeral services for Aaron J. Aalborg, 65 years old, who died at the home of his son, Floyd, in Fairmont, Minn., Saturday evening, are to be held here Wednesday afternoon. The first service will be in the Sternborg Funeral home at 1:30 p. m. and at 2 o'clock in the Methodist church.

The Rev. F. W. Ortmeyer had charge of both services.

Interment was in the East Side cemetery beside the body of his wife, who preceded him in death six years ago.

Mr. Aalborg was born in Racine, Wis., Feb. 17, 1870. When he was five years old her parents moved to Viborg, S. D., where he grew to manhood. He received his early education in the schools of Viborg and later he went to College View, Neb., to complete his education.

In his early years he was a photographer by profession, operating a studio at Armstrong for a number of years. He was married to Nellie Johnson, Dec. 30, 1897 at Estherville, where he continued to make his home until his death.

To this union two children were born, Floyd and Rosella, both of whom live in Fairmont, Minn. For the past 20 years Mr. Aalborg has been a roof contractor.

The past few months Mr. Aalborg had been staying at the home of his son and working with him.

Mr. Aalborg is survived by his son Floyd and daughter, Mrs. Paul Carter and grandchildren, Kenneth and LaVonne, all of Fairmont, Minn., five brothers, Joe Aalborg of Estherville, the Rev. Nathan Aalborg of Cedar Rapids, Dan Aalborg of Sioux Falls, S. D., Charles Aalborg of Viborg, S. D., one sister Mrs. Raph Packard of Bellflower, Calif.
