## **FUNERAL SERVICES HELD ON MONDAY FOR CALEB LUND**

Funeral services for Caleb Lund were held on Monday, Nov. 12, 1973, from Our Redeemer Lutheran Church, with Pastor David Eggebraten officiating. Organist was Mrs. Melvin Peterson and soloist was Mr. Curtis Anderson. Pallbearers were, Scott Nielsen, Richard Solheim, Leif Solheim, Robert Hansen, Richard Hansen, and Larry Waterman. Interment was in Carlson Cemetery.

Caleb Ferdinand Lund was born in Big Springs Township near Alcester, South Dakota, on December 3, 1885. He was the son of Mr. and Mrs. Carl Frederick Lund, pioneer Swedish immigrants. He spent his boyhood on a farm in the Alcester community, moving with his parents and family to a farm in Salem Township, Turner County, at the age of 17.

On November 26, 1912, he was united in marriage to Anna Nilson, and to this union, three sons and seven daughters were born.

Caleb spent all of his active years farming near Viborg, South Dakota, and had lived in their present home 18 years, until his final illness.

He passed away on Thursday, November 8, following hospitalization and surgery at Sacred Heart Hospital in Yankton, S. D. He was 87 years, 11 months and five days of age.

He is survived by his wife, Anna; and nine children, Carl of Yankton, S. D., Edith (Mrs. Earl Hansen) of Irene, S. D., Myrtle (Mrs. Charles Bridenstine) of Finlayson, Minn., Mrs. Norma Waterman of Hinckley, Minn., Verda (Mrs. Orva Taylor) of Salem, Ore., Ferne (Mrs. Richard Solheim) of Sioux City, Ia., Arnold of Viborg, S. D., Dorothy (Mrs. Arthur Flyger, Jr.) of Sioux Falls, S. D., and Lenore (Mrs. Norman O. Nielsen) of Viborg, S. D. There are also 38 grandchildren and 23 great-grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by his parents, three sisters, and an infant son, Lloyd Arnold.
