Last Rites Held Saturday For Mrs. Carrie Johnson

Funeral services for Mrs. Carrie Johnson were held Saturday, April 11th, at the Viborg Methodist Church with Rev. Chester Custer of Hawarden, Ia., and Rev. Robert McBride officiating. Pallbearers were Ellius Johnson, Ben Johnson, Art Loe, Byron Hendry, Russell Hammond, Eddie Apland and John Wolff. Mrs. Wesley Peterson and daughter, Roberta, sang "The Old Rugged Cross" and "Does Jesus Care", and Mrs. Dan Bylander sang "Beyond The Sunset", accompanied by Mrs. Robert Ward at the piano. Barnard Funeral Home of Hawarden, Ia., were in charge. Interment was at Rosehill Cemetery in Viborg.

Mrs. Carrie Dorothy Johnson, daughter of Peter and Anna Pedersen, was born December 31, 1873, at Brunshus, Denmark, and passed away April 9, 1959, at the Pauska Home at Hawarden, Ia., at the age of 85 years, 3 months and 9 days.

When she was 15 years old she came to America and made her home with her brother, Nels Johnson and wife, at Hooker, S. Dak.

On February 7, 1891, she was united in marriage to Nels J. Johnson and also at that time she became an American citizen. To this union 5 children were born, one dying in infancy.

They spent most of their married life in Hooker, and on February 7, 1941, celebrated their Golden Wedding at the Hooker Hall. On March 10, 1947, they went to make their home with their daughter, Mrs. Hannah McManaman, in Hawarden, Ia., where they celebrated their 60th wedding anniversary.

On August 30, 1951, Mr. Johnson passed away, and Mrs. Johnson remained with her daughter until June 3, 1957, at which time she went to the Panska Home.

She was preceded in death by her parents, her husband, one son, two sisters, four brothers, and three grandchildren. She leaves to mourn her passing, two daughters, Mrs. Hannah McManaman of Hawarden, Ia., and Mrs. Della Frank of Rapid City, S. D., two sons, A. P. Johnson of Hawarden, Ia., and W. P. Johnson of Butte, Montana, 10 grandchildren, 6 great-grandchildren, one brother, Nels Johnson of Hooker, S. Dak., several nieces and nephews, and friends.
