Last Rites Held For Ray Dangel, Sr.

Funeral service for Raymond G. Dangel, Sr. was held Monday, November 29, 1993, at St. Boniface-Idylwilde Church, rural Freeman, with Father Dennis Benda officiating. Reader was Tom Healy.
