Last Rites For Marvin O. Heim

Services for Marvin O. Heim, 79, were held in Rapid City with burial in Black Hills National Cemetery.

He was born April 15, 1909, in Peever. His family moved to Viborg, where he grew up. He graduated from Viborg High School. He married Marie Christensen February 19, 1931, in Yankton.

He enlisted in the U.S. Navy during World War II. Upon his discharge he was appointed to the South Dakota Highway Patrol by Gov. M. Q. Sharp in 1944. He served with the Highway Patrol for 25 years, 15 years as captain of the Aberdeen district. He retired in 1969.

He served as police chief in Spearfish for one year.

He was past president of the Tri-State Peace Officers Association. He was a member of the Masonic Lodge, the Naja Shrine and the Scottish Rite. He was past worthy patron of the Eastern Star in Aberdeen. He was also a member of Trinity Lutheran Church.

His survivors include his wife, Marie, of Rapid City; one son, Marvin L. "Bud" of Rapid City; one daughter, Marilyn (Mrs. Edward) Frein of Rapid City; one brother, Clifford of Viborg; a sister, Ruby Bradley of Viborg; 5 grandchildren; and 5 great-grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by four brothers and one sister and his parents, Martin and Petra Heim.
