## FUNERAL SERVICES HELD FEB. 27 FOR ALFRED M. ANDAL

Funeral services for Alfred Andal were held on Tuesday, Feb. 27, 1979, at the Scandia Lutheran Church in Centerville with Pastor Arthur Grorud officiating. Casket bearers were Richard Gors, Jr., Jerald Andal, Eugene Danielson, Gary Willms, Larry Jacobsen, and Dan Westegaard. A quartette, Lauren Knutson, Boyd Ostrem Willard Knutson and Robert Ostrem, sang "How Great Thou Art" and "Beyond The Sunset". Accompanist was Mrs. Jerald Mammenga, and the organist was Mrs. Duane Lundquist. Interment was in the Holland Cemetery.

Alfred Martinus Andal was born November 17, 1895, near Centerville, South Dakota, the son of Ole and Sarah Olson Andal, and entered into death on February 23, 1979, at the age of 83 years, 3 months and 6 days.

He was baptized and confirmed in the Lutheran faith and was a member of Immanuel Lutheran Church at the time of his passing. He was a veteran of World War I serving with the United States Army in France.

On October 8, 1919, Alfred was united in marriage to Inga Osthus at Sisseton, South Dakota. The couple farmed one mile west of Hooker. Inga preceded him in death in 1930. On March 10, 1943, he was married to Sena Anderson. They also farmed in the Centerville area. After Sena's death in 1966, Alfred continued to live at Centerville and for the past two years has been a resident of Good Samaritan Center.

He leaves to mourn his passing, two sons, James and Verdell, both of Centerville; two daughters, Sylvia (Mrs. Richard Gors) and Mary Ann (Mrs. Warren Nelson) both of Viborg; two brothers, Joe of Irene and Melvin of Wakonda; three sisters, Mrs. Mabel Osthus of Centerville, Miss Alma Andal of Wakonda, and Mrs. Evelyn Wrage of Viborg; nine grandchildren and 11 great-grandchildren. He was also preceded in death by his parents, two children, Alyce and Arnold, four brothers and one sister.
