Sena Marie Johnson was born on April 20, 1914, on the family farm south of Turkey Ridge, Turner County, South Dakota to Hans Peter Johnson and Anna Christina (Jorgensen) Johnson, the youngest of eight children. She was baptized at Spring Valley Lutheran church, rural Viborg. She attended Salem #27 rural school and secretarial college.

Sena married Leslie Pasco and they were the parents of a son, Charles. They moved to Washington where Sena worked as a secretary in Port Angeles and Seattle.

Sena married Don Luckey on June 14, 1947, and they made their home in Fircrest, Washington. Sena died at Allenmoore Hospital, Tacoma, Washington, on October 7, 2000.

Sena is survived by her husband; daughter-in-law, Susan Pasco; grandchildren, Zak Pasco and Molly and her husband Wes; and, great grandson, Max Charles Hays, all of the Seattle area.
