CHARLES E. CHRISTENSEN

Private funeral services were held at the home of Edwin H. Christensen August 9th, 1948, with Rev. W. Morris Kildal-officiating, for Charles E. Christensen, whose remains were recently returned from the Military Cemetery Hamm, in Luxembourg. The Hansen Funeral Home was in charge of arrangements. Burial was made in the cemetery east of Viborg.

Charles E. Christensen was born July 7, 1920, on a farm in Turner County, Viborg, South Dakota. He was baptised and confirmed in the Lutheran Faith. He graduated from Viborg High School in 1939. He was inducted into the army on August 6, 1942, at Fort Leavenworth, Kansas. P.F.C. Christensen was then sent to Camp Swift, Texas, where he was assigned to Company 'M', 378th Infantry, 95th Division. He was killed on December 15, 1944, while crossing the Saar river near Lisdorf, Germany. P.F.C. Christensen was in General Patton's 3rd Army at the time of his death.

P.F.C. Charles E. Christensen is survived by his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Edwin H. Christensen, a sister, Correne, and brother, Delano. He was preceded in death by one older brother.
