Lillian Monk, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. N. C. Olson, was born December 5th, 1886. At the age of ten years, she came with her parents to South Dakota and settled on a farm 2 miles south-east of Viborg. Here she attended public school, including 1 year of music at Sioux Falls College.

At an early age, she accepted Christ and united with the First Baptist Church of Viborg where she served in many ways, particularly in connection with the Choir. She was united in marriage June 28, 1907, to Harvey E. Monk, to which union two sons were born. For many years she was an active member of the Eastern Star and American Legion Auxiliary.

Fourteen years ago, Mr. and Mrs. Monk moved to Beresford, S. D., where they have made their home ever since. In this new home they continued their activity in Church and Social circles. Several months ago she began to suffer a lingering illness which resulted in her death at a Sioux Falls hospital on Sunday A. M., March 14th, at the age of 62 years, 3 months and 9 days. Preceding her in death were her parents, two sisters and three brothers. She leaves to mourn her loss her husband, two sons, Burrell G. of Sioux Falls and Homer H. of Norway, Ia., and their wives, two grandchildren, Dennis and Gail Monk, one brother, David, of Ogden, Utah, and many friends who will greatly miss her.
