OBITUARY

John Peterson was born April 4, 1853 at Skoana, Sweden. He came to Denmark at the age of 14 years.

Mr. Peterson was married twice. His first wife's name was Amalia Sorenson, who died about 46 years ago. To that union were born 3 children who are in this country. Mr. Peterson was married a second time to Johanna Marie Larsson. In that union were born to them 6 children. Two of the preceeded their father's death. Mr. and Mrs. Peterson came to this country in the year of 1904 and settled at Jewel, Iowa. They came to Viborg, So. Dak. in 1906 and have lived in this vicinity ever since.

Mr. Peterson began ailing in the month of February. He finally contracted pneumonia which caused his death on the 1st day of June, 1932 and was thus 79 years and 2 months old. He leaves to mourn his loss his wife and children of first marriage: Mrs. Marie Hansen, Soren Christian Peterson and Mrs. Kjergaard; of the second marriage Jens Adolph, Mrs. Peter Rasmussen, Mrs. Charley Christensen and a step son, Chas. Sorenson. He leaves 24 grand children and 4 great grand children.
